Ambassadors are encouraged to play a role in the governing board (Federation) and be program leaders; help the program coordinator by helping plan and lead programs and events for our 4-H members throughout the year.

By serving as a Crow Wing County 4-H Ambassador, you will:

- Attend 1 meeting per month (*virtual or in person*)
- Make new friends
- Set individual and group goals
- You may decide on a specific focus area for your group and County program
- Lead activities at various 4-H events for younger youth (*virtual or in person*)
- Help throughout the fair with specific responsibilities
- Promote the ambassador program with other clubs and throughout the county
- Gain leadership skills -- *This is a great opportunity to take part in and list on job and college applications!*

To join the 2020-21 Crow Wing County 4-H Ambassador team, complete these two things:

1. Register today by filling out the New Ambassador Application form found on the county website. **Register by November 1, 2020.** Any youth can join our team at any point in the year.
2. **Attend our Welcome Gathering! This will be sent up in November after registrations are collected for the 2020-2021 year.**
